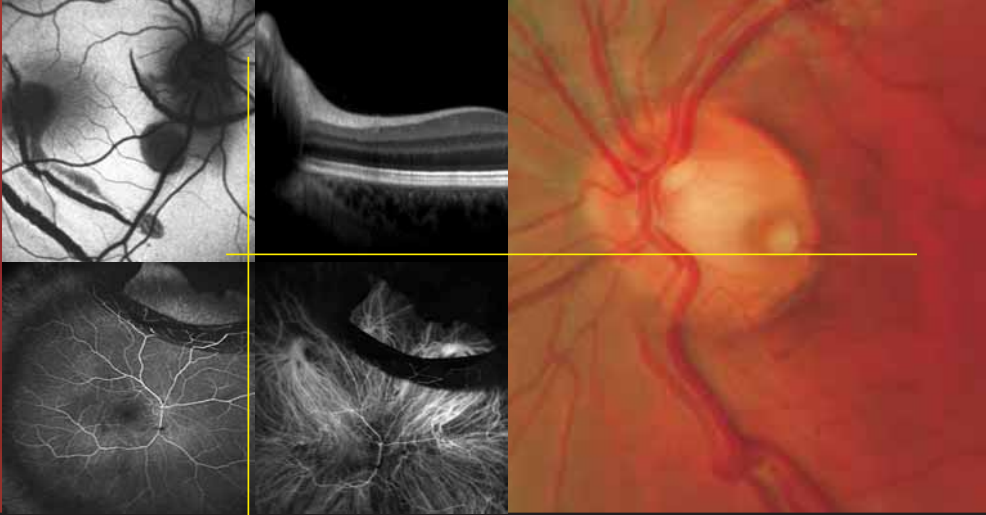

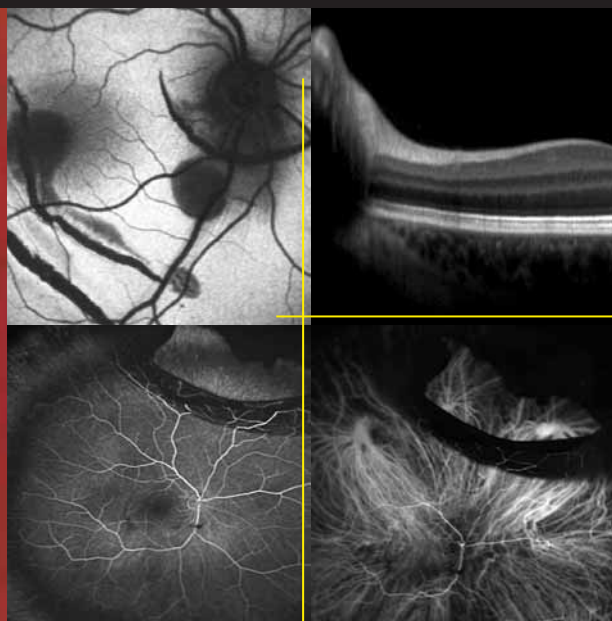

Dear colleagues,

*new insights into retinal diseases have been brought
by recent improvements in retinal imaging.*

The meeting will be split up into two different parts. The first will be in Sexten (Val Pusteria) where the goal is to answer some questions such as measurement and classification of macular edema and definition of active choroidal neovascular lesion.

The second will take place in the Como lake area and will be divided in two sessions: a more technical one, in collaboration with the Ophthalmic Photographers' Society, will deal with all the new devices; a second one will be characterized by conventional lectures covering OCT, fundus autofluorescence, Indocyanine green angiography, wide field and stereo imaging, microperimetry adaptive optics.
